The leadership camp is a 6 day learning and social camping event for Sons of the American Legion and American Legion Auxiliary junior aged 8-17. Campers have the opportunity to learn about the American Legion Family and to meet other juniors from across the state and win awards for their efforts.

Campers will have time for team events and some field trips to educational and fun places.

The camp is held on the first week of June annually and the location moves around the state to give maximum exposure to the youth.

Registration cost is \$25.00 per camper, which covers their shirts, meals, as well as all materials and entertainment.

The staff is composed of Legion, Auxiliary and Sons members from all over the state.

In past Years Campers have learned how to fold the American Flag, how to properly raise and lower it as well as the pledge of allegiance and proper flag retirement.

One group, all from the same post, were invited to the post flag retirement ceremony and commented that the post was doing it wrong. They were told "ok let's see you do it". To the astonishment of all, 4 juniors, all former campers, took over and performed the ceremony flawlessly.

Campers learn the history of the Legion and Auxiliary as well and a basic understanding of how they operate. Some campers have gone on to become officers at the post, district and State levels in the Legion Auxiliary and the Sons.

The Junior Leadership Camp is an opportunity to teach our younger members about the organizations and to develop them into future leaders

During the camp week the SAL Juniors and the Junior Auxiliary hold their annual state level conventions. Campers learn how to do their campaigns and the proper procedures for conducting a meeting and the nomination and election of officers.
